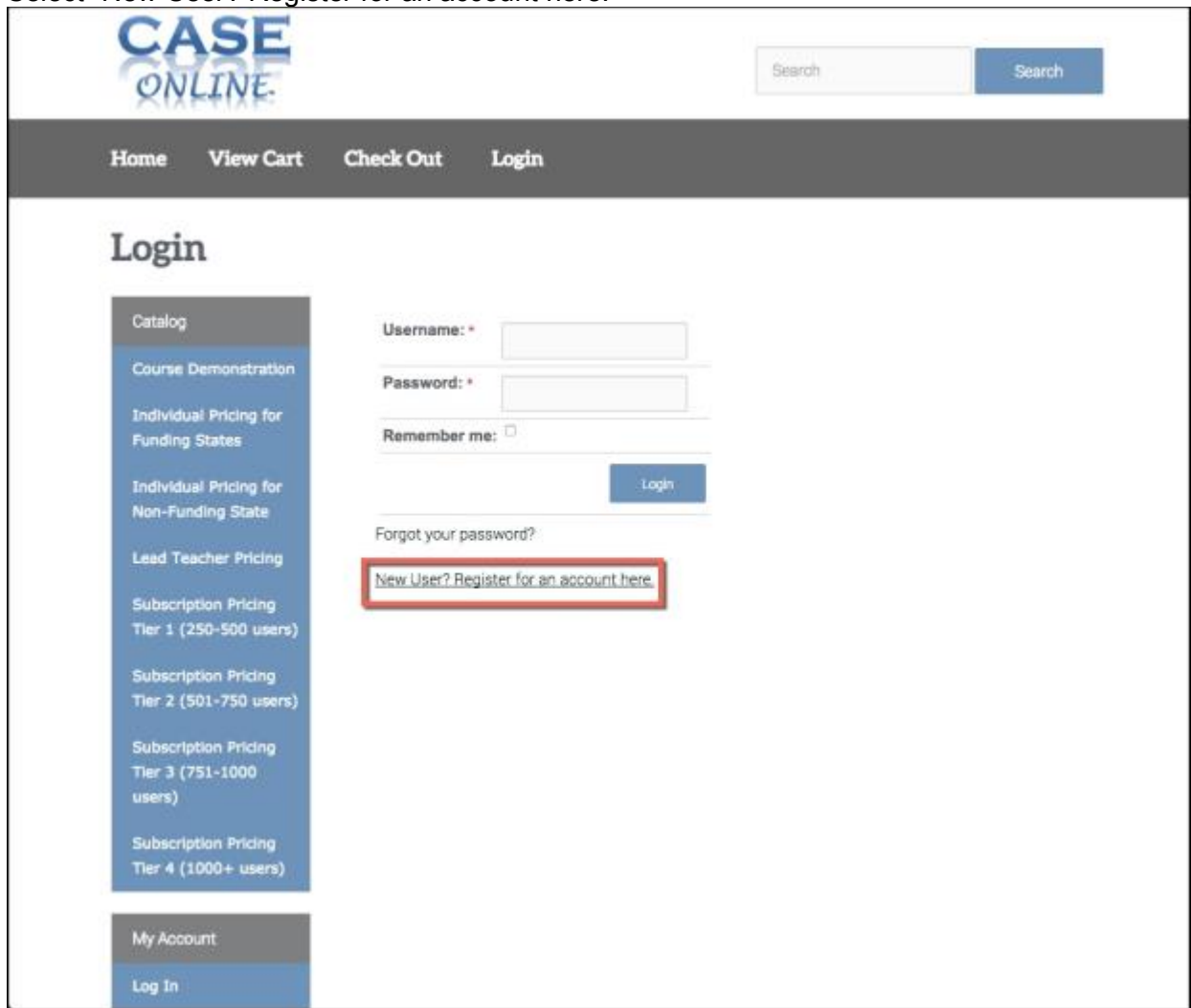


Figure 2. CASE Online Login

6. Select the catalog item that corresponds to your pricing structure. For example, if you are a teacher in a funding state you would select “Individual Pricing for Funding States” to place your order.

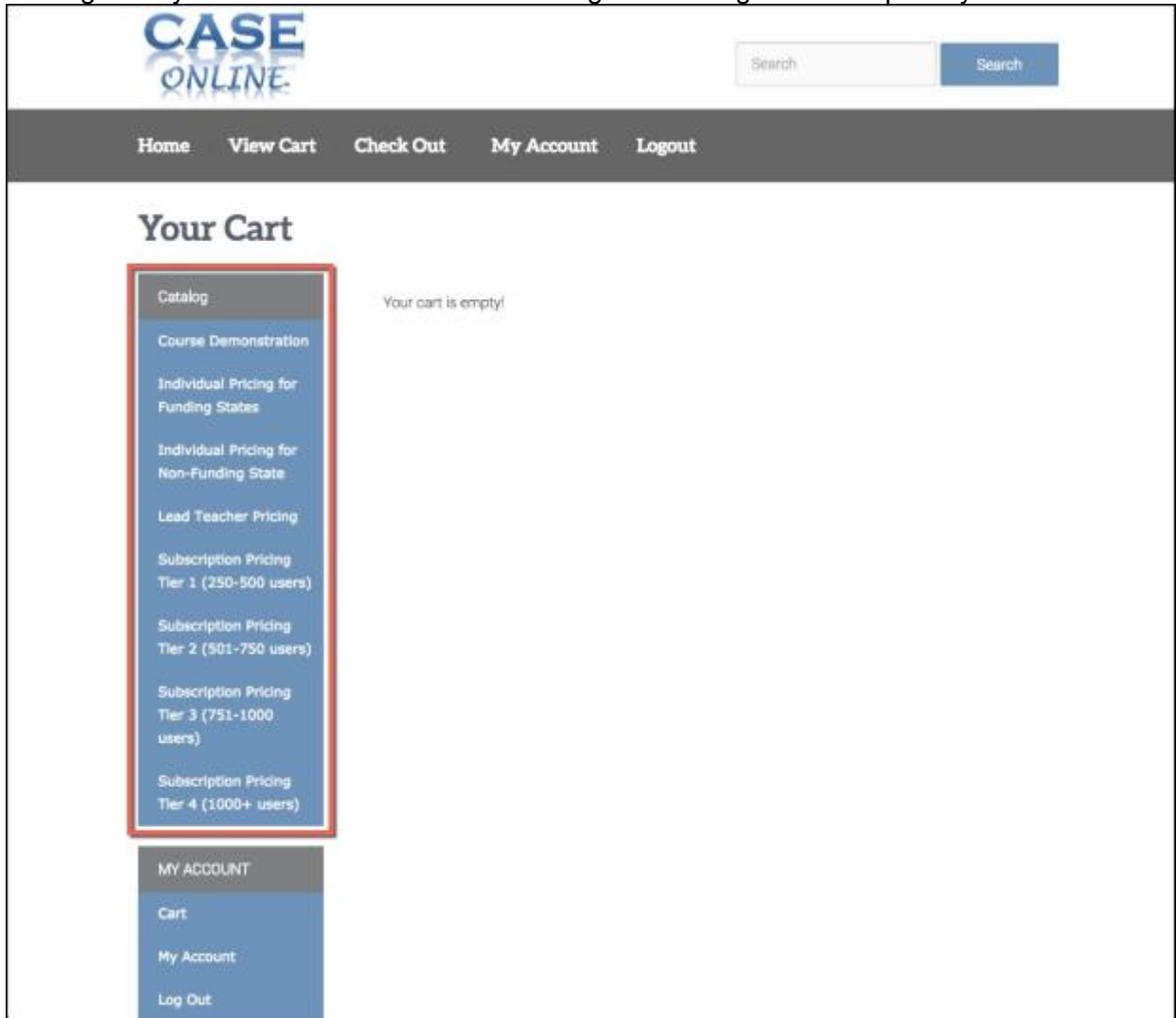


Figure 4. CASE Online eCommerce User View

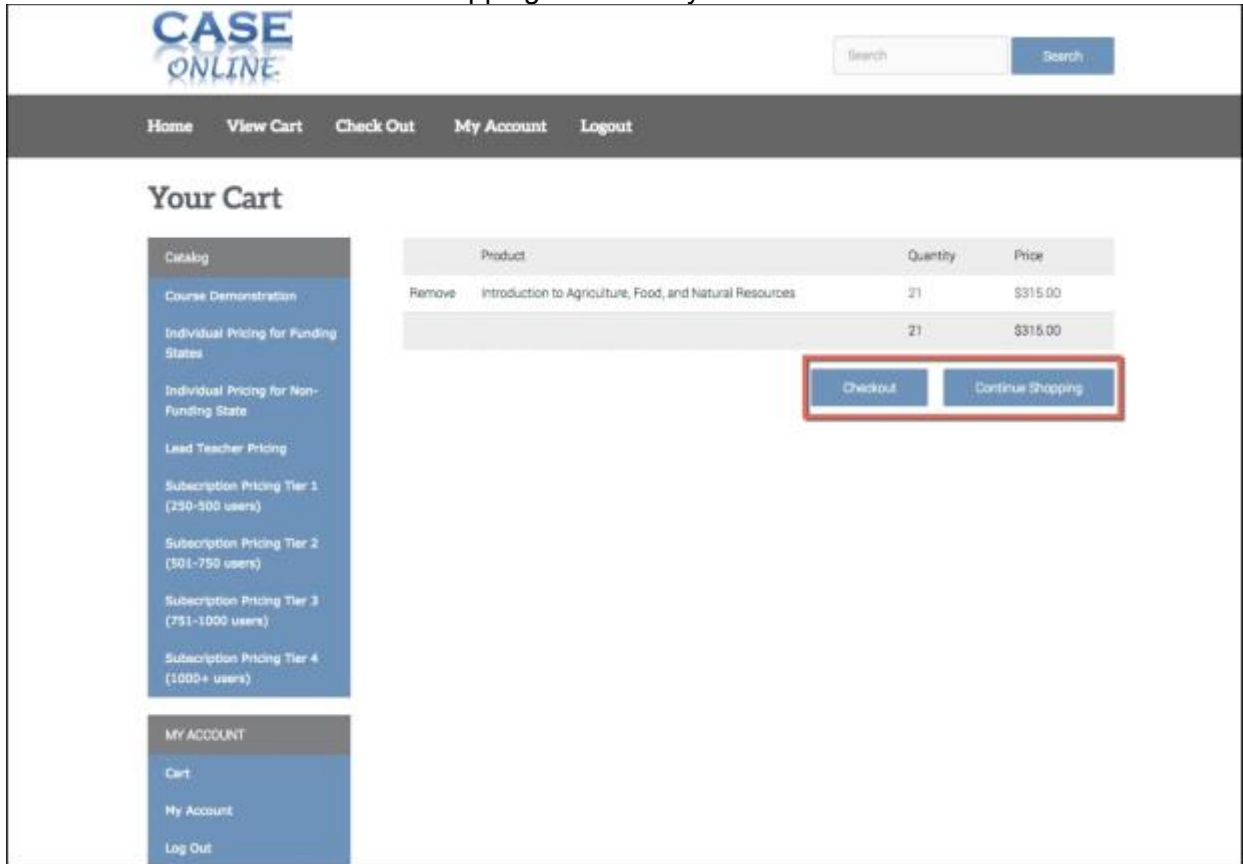


Figure 7. CASE Online eCommerce Shopping Cart
